### BEST OF THE MIDWEST CONTEST INFORMATION

#### Solo Division

Soloists will perform Saturday morning and afternoon in the Performing Arts Center between each ensemble. Each soloist is allotted six minutes for his or her performance, and may utilize one live acoustic instrument.

Trophies will be presented to the Grand Champion soloist and first and second runners-up. The winners will be announced in the Performing Arts Center at the conclusion of the competition, approximately 9:00 pm.

#### Middle School Choir Division

The middle school choirs will perform Friday evening in the Performing Arts Center. Trophies will be presented to the Grand Champion and first and second runners-up. There will be caption awards for Outstanding Costuming, Tech Crew, Vocal Sound and Visual Effect. The winners will be announced in the Performing Arts Center after the C.G. Accents exhibition performance.

#### Mixed & Women's **Division**

RDH Adjudication Concepts, an independent organization, is overseeing the adjudication of the mixed and women's choirs. Groups will perform throughout Saturday in the Performing Arts Center.

At the conclusion of the exhibition performance by CG Sound System, the results of the eight judges: 2 adjudicators on Ensemble Music, 2 adjudicators on Ensemble Visual, 2 adjudicators on General Effect Music and 2 adjudicators on General Effect Visual scores will be added up and turned into a final score.

Division awards will be given for Women and Small Mixed. Championship awards - the combination of small and large mixed show choirs - will be based on overall scores. Specialty awards for Outstanding Ensemble Music, Ensemble Visual and General Effect will be handed out.

Choirs will be recognized for placement and participation.

## **COMPETITION JUDGES**



Jena Adrianson holds a degree in Music Education from the University of Indianapolis and a Master of Arts degree from Ball State University. She has taught choir in Indianapolis at both the middle school and high school level. Jena began her teaching career in her hometown of Marion, Indiana. She has since taught at Decatur Central High School, served as Alumni Director for the University of Indianapolis and retired in June 2012 as the Director of Choral Activities at Lawrence Central High School in Indianapolis where she taught for 21 years. Her show choirs have been named Grand Champion numerous times, earning caption awards for Outstanding Vocals, Outstanding Visuals and Outstanding Soloist.



Dwight Edwards now spends his time running a veterinary hospital, teaching movement to opera students at Mannes School of Music and private coaching. He has performed and directed/choreographed many theater productions and taught master classes in dance styles and audition techniques. He taught choral music at North Central High School in Indianapolis, Indiana after graduating from Ball State University where he was a member of the Ball State Singers. He has choreographed show choirs around the country including the Carmel Ambassadors.



Mr. Lamonte Kuskye is a graduate of Ball State University. With an emphasis in choral conducting, Lamonte has earned a reputation as choral clinician and adjudicator in the Midwest, including choral festivals and ISSMA state convention in Indianapolis. He is currently the director of the Carmel High School Ambassadors in Carmel, Indiana. This group won both the 2007 and 2008 Indiana State School Music Association State Show Choir Championships. His groups have toured around the world at festivals and national competitions. With a love for theatre, Lamonte has received best actor awards for the roles of Will in The Will Rogers' Follies, Curly in Oklahoma, and Bobby in Crazy for You at Indianapolis Civic Theatre. He has is currently the music director at Pendleton First United Methodist Church.



Valerie Lippoldt Mack, music chair and dance instructor at Butler Community College in El Dorado, Kansas has gained experience and recognition as a music educator and professional choreographer throughout the United States. Her choreography has been featured at Carnegie Hall, Disney World, national ACDA conventions and MENC workshops, the Miss America pageant and various national showchoir competitions and festivals around the country. In 2010, the Butler Headliners were one of four finalists in NBC's Today's "Show Choir Showdown" and performed for more than 8.5 million viewers. Valerie's newest resource book, Putting the SHOW in Choir! is a great source for teachers, choreographers, administrators and parents.



Mrs. Rebecca Noot, who earned the Indianapolis Prelude Awards' Outstanding Arts Educator Award in 1999, recently retired after teaching music for 33 years, including 14 years as Choral at Franklin Central High School. During her tenure, the F.C. Singers began competing, winning many awards as Grand Champions and finalists throughout central Indiana and at various festivals in the eastern United States. She also established the school's first women's choir as well as a chamber choir. In addition to her years at Franklin Central, she has taught general music and choir in elementary, middle, and intermediate school, and currently enjoys presenting choral clinics, critiquing choral rehearsals of contest shows and offering critiques to groups preparing for ISSMA organizational contests, as well as adjudicating choral contests and festivals every year.

Shawn Porter is a Choral Director at Hamilton Southeastern High, where he directs, co-directs or accompanies five choirs, and teaches piano. Shawn received his bachelor's degree from Anderson (Indiana) University, his Master of Music degree from Ball State University, and a second Master of Science degree in School Counseling from Butler University. Mr. Porter's all-female and mixed shows choirs have consistently been named Grand Champions, and have received many caption awards in numerous contests, including Grand Champion at the Showstoppers National Show Choir Competition. He is an active choral clinician and adjudicator throughout the Midwest, a church choir director/organist, a member of Music Educators National Conference, and an avid traveler.



Christopher D. Pratt is a 1995 graduate of Center Grove High School. He obtained a BS in Music Education (2000) from Ball State University and a MS in Educational Leadership (2011) from Indiana University. With a foundation in choral music and choreography, Mr. Pratt has also worked extensively with choirs around the Midwest as a show consultant/coach. Currently, Mr. Pratt is the Director of Choirs at Grosse Pointe South High in Grosse Pointe Farms, Michigan. At GPS, Mr. Pratt directs four choirs including the highly acclaimed Pointe Singers and Tower Belles, who just completed their seventh year of performing with Detroit's Symphony Orchestra. Most recently, Mr. Pratt was Choral Director at Center Grove High School. At Center Grove he directed five choirs, including the nationally award-winning show choir CG Sound System and chamber choir, CG Singers.



Greg Sanders is an active choral musician in Indianapolis, serving as the Artistic Director of the Indianapolis Men's Chorus, music director at All Souls Unitarian Church. 




