Step 2	<p>Accept the position: immediately complete the Competitive Choir Contract found on the results page at www.centergrovechoirs.org</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - All parties who are financially responsible must fill out a contract <p>Decline the position: email the directors immediately as there will be waitlist</p>
FAQ's	<p>What if I don't see my name on the audition results list?</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Be sure you have completed the registration - then contact Mrs. Dice or Mr. Norman. 2. If none of these above apply to you - contact Mrs. Dice or Mr. Norman. Everyone who has completed all registration information and attends this meeting should find their child's name on a list.
