FOR PERFORMERS

- There are no finals
- Concert Choirs will perform in the auditorium using four step risers in front of the show choir risers
- Performers will enter the school at door #2 and go to their homerooms to change for their performance
- There will be homerooms and we will split groups in half
- Performers will not be allowed in the auditorium to watch their other groups performances.
- **Singers have the option to perform without their masks. There will be no penalty either way. They must “mask up” immediately after the performance.**
- Our award ceremony will be streamed online – neither choirs nor their reps will be present in person

FOR AUDIENCE MEMBERS

- Audience members will be given packets of sanitary wipes (similar to airline wipes) on their way into the auditorium and the solo room so that they may sanitize their seats
- Masks and social distancing are required for all non-performers
- Crew members must remain backstage
- Tickets will be sold up to the limit of the auditorium seating, which is 250 at this time
- In-person ticket purchases will be online. Spectators will show their tickets on their phone when they arrive at Avon. They are good for your block of time (on Friday), or your school (on Saturday).
- For those who cannot or don't wish to purchase an in-person ticket, we will be selling tickets also to an online video stream in cooperation with Music For All.



Dear Spectators,

Welcome to Avon High School and the 2021 Avon Vocal Invitational. Here is some information that will be helpful to you as you attend this event.

DIRECTIONS

From I-465 take Rockville Rd West. Turn South on Dan Jones Rd. Turn Right on East County Rd 150 South. Turn left at the light into the school. Drive around to the back for parking.

PARKING

Spectator parking is in the southwest student lot

ENTRANCE

Enter door #33. You may not enter the school until your school is scheduled to arrive—one hour before they perform. You must leave the school building immediately following your school's block

ADMISSION

- 1) you may purchase tickets online for in-person admission to your school's performance.
- 2.) you may purchase the online version, which will allow you to view all of the day's performances. A link that allows you to purchase either option will be sent to your director when they become live.

Once the door closes for a performance, it will remain closed until the performance is concluded. Please be sure to arrive in enough time to enter the performance venue prior to the scheduled performance time.
